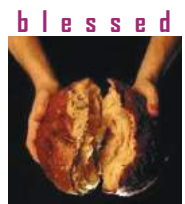

Franciscan Northside Ministries - reaching out with the heart and hands of Christ to all!

Each week, as Ken and I pull up to the Food Pantry at Assumption, we get in line behind either the Bread Truck, or the Food Bank Truck or another vehicle unloading donated items. Today, as we unloaded our 70 gallons of milk, we noticed all the bins that are usually full of vegetables or bread were empty. There was a line of clients waiting for the Free Health Clinic - it was -5 degrees outside and the waiting area was frigid. Despite the cold, we were greeted with smiles from the clients and warm conversation from the Br. Gerry and Br. Jim. The kitchen always smells of homemade soup and Br. Gerry is always hard at work cooking up the daily lunch. Sr. Dolly is usually busy with Tuesday Coffee & Donuts, but is always there for a hug and a thank-you to the parishioners of St. Charles-St. Ann.

This coming February 1<sup>st</sup>, our YIM Youth in Ministry is holding a pancake breakfast to benefit this Northside Ministry. We have a real connection with them that goes beyond just milk. Many of our parishioners volunteer there on a regular basis. We want you all to know what goes on there on North Salina St. Sister Dolly is the Director of the Northside Ministries and she left St. Ann's in 1998, after 5 years of being the Director of Religious Ed. to start this ministry. Her dear friend, Sr. J.P. runs the Poverello Health Clinic. This small little clinic is attached to the Pantry and they offer free health visits under the direction of 20 volunteer Physicians. Sr. J.P. herself is a registered nurse. Br. James Amrhein & Br. Gerry keep the Food Pantry running smoothly with help from Ashley, a Franciscorp volunteer. Each day that Pantry not only hands out bags of food, but they serve sandwiches and soup from the walk-up window. Each month they serve 7500-12,000 sandwiches to anyone who needs a meal!



All the money from our Pancake Breakfast will be donated to the Franciscan Northside Ministry. Mark your calendar, join us for breakfast and help our YIM support this Mission of Love on the Northside.
