## Souper Bowl of Caring 2018

28 years ago, the "Souper Bowl of Caring" began with a simple prayer from a youth group: "Lord even as we enjoy the Super Bowl football game, help us be mindful of those without a bowl of soup to eat".

Since that day, youth groups from all religious denominations have collected more than \$100 million for local charities across the country on this, the most materialistic day of the year. A 30 second commercial this year could reach 6 million dollars. This year our YIM Youth in Ministry group will take part again in this effort by collecting and donating all funds to three of the inner city Catholic Food Pantries: Assumption, Cathedral and St. Lucy's. We have invited the youth of St. Patrick and St. Brigid to join us in this effort. Every penny collected, in every participating church goes directly to the local charities of choice.

*On Super Bowl weekend, February 3 & 4, 2018*, look for our young people standing with soup pots as you exit Church and help our inner city pantries purchase necessities and food.

During the game that night, think about those who go without food on a daily basis. By supporting this effort we all put a new meaning to Souper Bowl Sunday.

In St. Charles and St. Ann's church, anyone who is not able to come up in the Communion procession to receive the Eucharist, please know that a minister will come to you if you are seated in the pews at the back of the church.

If you are bringing Communion to the homebound or to a loved one, you must transport the host in a sacred vessel known as a pyx. That is the only proper way to carry the Eucharist. Please ask the priest or deacon for a pyx before Mass that you can use for this purpose.

If you have borrowed a pyx from the church, please return the pyx when you are finished with it so it may be used by others.

As you know, it is a great privilege to serve as a minister in the church. We always welcome new ministers. If you would like to be trained to serve as an altar server, lector, or Eucharistic Minister, we welcome and encourage you to do so. Please let Dc. Tony know.

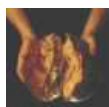

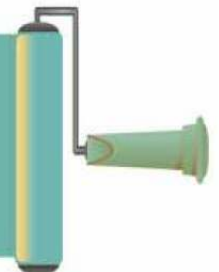
